Offsite lodging options:

Joshua Tree Inn: Located in downtown Joshua Tree, this is a very special place. It's intimate, with only 11 rooms available, each one with its own unique vibe. Room 8 is where Gram Parsons spent his last few hours and is locally known as the quintessential "Cosmic American Experience" to fans of country rock.
